2. <u>Arrangements for the Second Term Post-Exam Script Checking (19 - 25/6)</u>

According to the arrangement of the school calendar, there will be a total of 5 days from June 19 (Wednesday) to June 25 (Tuesday), 2024, as the paper checking week. During the paper checking week, full-day classes will be resumed, and the class time will be from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm. Secondary 1 to 3 students are required to stay in school for lunch; extracurricular activities have also been completed.

3. <u>F.3 Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA)</u>

The TSA assessment will be held on 19th June and 20th June. All Secondary 3 students are required to take the TSA. The TSA reports and school reports provide information about students' strengths and weaknesses against specific Basic Competencies, which helps schools and teachers to enhance their plans on learning and teaching.

If students are absent because of sickness on the assessment days, parents should notify school of sick leave by E-class App or phone (2445 0800) between 7:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.. It is a must to submit a valid medical certificate within 3 school working days when students come back to school. For personal leave, parents must submit the application through E-class App or with a parent's letter at least 3 school working days in advance.

24th June, 2024 (Monday) is a reserved day for assessment if there is any unexpected condition that leads to the suspension of the assessment. If there is no suspension of the assessment, students are required to attend classes according to the original timetable.

To let schools, students and parents better understand the municipal solid waste charging plan that will be implemented following information is provided by the Environmental Protection Department of HKSAR government.



Legislative Requirements and Penalties

Under the mode of "Charging by Bags/ Labels", it constitutes an offence if you dispose of waste that has not been properly wrapped in Designated Bags or affixed with Designated Labels at the above places. **Violators could be fined \$1,500**; prosecution by way of summons may be brought against serious or repeated offenders.
