#### 4. English Department

4.1 To help Secondary 3 students better understand and adapt to the senior secondary English curriculum, the English Department will hold a bridging course for students transitioning from Secondary 3 to Secondary 4 from July 21 to 25, from 12:45 PM to 2:00 PM. This course will use school-based materials and be taught by experienced teachers from our school. It is free, with 25 spots available. Students who are interested should sign up with their English teachers.

4.2 After the summer holidays, Secondary 5 students will begin preparing for university subject selection. To enhance their chances of university admission, the English Department will offer an IELTS (International English Language Testing System) intensive training course from August 11 to 15, from 8:30 AM to 10:30 AM. The school has specially invited experienced external IELTS instructors to teach the course. The tuition is fully subsidized by the school, with 25 available spots. Interested students should register with their English teachers.

In order to enable students to make good use of their spare time after examinations and enrich their subject knowledge and extracurricular knowledge through different learning activities, the school will arrange a variety of life-wide learning activities for students of all levels after the examinations.
