Visit to the National Security Exhibition Gallery of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (S.2)

The National Security Exhibition Gallery ("the Gallery") formally opened on 7 August 2024. It is the first thematic gallery in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) dedicated to systematic promotion of national security education, and is also the first national security education base in the HKSAR. To enhance students' understanding on the importance of national security, the Education Bureau arranges schools to visit the Gallery progressively to supplement the related learning activities. Remarks:	1. As the exhibition hall can only accommodate one form of students in each period, students of different levels must visit and participate in guided tours at different times, so classes on the day of the event have been cancelled. 2. There will be no lunch arrangements in the school canteen on the day of the event, and lunch orders for that day have been cancelled from the October lunch order form. 3. Transport: Coaches will be arranged to transfer students to the Gallery from school and return after the visit; 4. Students should wear school uniform and behave in an orderly manner during the visit; 5. Students may take photos and record videos during the event for memory. However, they should not capture images of other visitors or staff of the Gallery to avoid any potential disputes. Additionally, the use of flash photography, selfie sticks, or tripods is prohibited to prevent inconvenience to other visitors. Without the permission of the staff at the Hong Kong Museum of History, please do not bring promotional banners, flags, or flyers bearing slogans into the Gallery. 6. As the visit is part of the learning process, students must participate. If they are unable to attend due to personal reasons, they must apply for leave three working days before the event. If they are unable to attend due to illness, they must submit a doctor's certificate valid on that day. Students will need to make up for the relevant learning content later.
